- monitor and measure its environmental performance and effectiveness of the EMS.
- continually improve our environmental performance.

KCOM's Health, Safety and Environmental Sustainability Board Sub-Committee has responsibility for overseeing the performance of KCOM's environmental objectives, risks and opportunities, and to review and monitor its EMS performance.

All KCOM employees are responsible for implementing and maintaining the EMS, and the Executive Leadership Team will ensure that sufficient resources are provided to support the EMS.
