

# SCHEDULE 116

## Operator NationalCalls

### 1. Definitions

- 1.1 In this Schedule 116, a reference to a paragraph or Appendix unless stated otherwise, is to a paragraph or Appendix of this Schedule 116. Words and expressions have the meaning given in Clause 1, except as shown below:

**"Operator NationalCall"**

a Call made by a Calling Party dialling the Number Ranges specified in Appendix 116.1 followed by an Operator NationalCall Service Provider's number which sets up the Call to the Operator NationalCall Service Provider and which if such a Call were made by an Operator Customer on the Operator System would be charged at the Operator's long distance national telephony charge from time to time, and an additional charge is paid by the Operator NationalCall Service Provider;

**"Operator NationalCall Service Provider"**

a person who has contracted with the Operator for the delivery of Calls using telephone numbers commencing with the Number Ranges specified in Appendix 116.1 The expression shall also include the Operator in respect of such telephone numbers where the Operator has published those numbers as being available to call the Operator itself in respect of certain Operator services.

### 2. Description of Service

- 2.1 Subject to the provisions of this Schedule 116, the Operator shall convey Operator NationalCalls handed over from the KCH System to the appropriate terminal apparatus nominated by the Operator NationalCall Service Provider or by the Operator where the terminal apparatus is connected to the Operator System, or to the KCH System or a Third Party Operator's system where the terminal equipment is connected to that System or Third Party operator's system.

- 2.2 Operator NationalCalls shall be included in the Traffic Forecast in accordance with Annex 3.
- 2.3 The parties shall agree in advance all necessary technical requirements, including Call set-up and clear down sequences, for the conveyance of Calls pursuant to this Schedule 116.
- 2.4 The Operator shall convey Operator NationalCalls handed over from the Operator System during those periods of time and at the same standard and quality of service as the Operator conveys similar Calls.
- 2.5 Each party shall correct faults which occur in its System which affect the conveyance of Operator NationalCalls in accordance with such party's normal engineering practices. For the avoidance of doubt, neither party warrants that its System is, or will be, free from faults.
- 2.6 Where there are abnormally high volumes of Operator NationalCalls that the Operator System cannot convey, KCH may apply network management controls in the KCH System or the Operator may apply network management controls in the Operator System.
- 2.7 International Calls are not conveyed pursuant to this Schedule 116.

### **3. Routing**

- 3.1 The conveyance of Operator NationalCalls shall be in accordance with the routing principles specified in Annex 3.
- 3.2 Operator NationalCalls handed over to the Operator shall be handed over at an Operator Switch Connection which is as near as reasonably practicable to the geographical location from which the Call was initially made or as otherwise may be agreed in writing by the parties.

### **4. Charging**

- 4.1 For the conveyance of each Operator NationalCall by the Operator, KCH shall pay the Operator a charge calculated in accordance with the rate for such a Call specified from time to time in the Kingston Interconnection Price List.

### **5. Commencement**

- 5.1 The Operator shall convey Operator NationalCalls handed over from the KCH System commencing on a date to be agreed in writing by the parties.
