

## SCHEDULE 2

### KCH Telephony Calls to the KCH System

#### 1. Definitions

- 1.1 In this Schedule 2, a reference to a paragraph or Appendix unless stated otherwise, is to a paragraph or Appendix of this Schedule 2. Words and expressions have the meaning given in Clause 1, except as shown below:

**"KCH Local Exchange Segment Call"** a KCH Telephony Call handed over from the Operator System to the KCH System at a KCH DLE, for delivery to a KCH Network Termination Point other than via a KCH Tandem Exchange;

**"KCH Single Tandem Segment Call"** a KCH Telephony Call handed over from the Operator System to the KCH System, initially switched at a KCH Tandem Exchange, and passed to a KCH DLE for delivery to a KCH Network Termination Point;

#### 2. Description of Service

- 2.1 Subject to the provisions of this Schedule 2, KCH shall convey KCH Telephony Calls handed over from the Operator System to the appropriate KCH Network Termination Point.
- 2.2 KCH International Incoming Calls, KCH Transit Calls, and KCH Operator to Operator Transit Calls are not conveyed pursuant to this Schedule.
- 2.3 The parties shall agree in advance all necessary technical requirements, including Call set-up and clear-down sequences, for the conveyance of Calls pursuant to this Schedule 2.
- 2.4 KCH's obligation to convey KCH ISDN Telephony Calls is subject to the respective Systems and all relevant Switch Connections of both parties being suitable for the conveyance of KCH ISDN Telephony Calls.
- 2.5 KCH shall not be obliged under this Schedule 2 to make its System suitable for the conveyance of KCH ISDN Telephony Calls or to provide equipment to its Customers enabling KCH ISDN Telephony Calls.
- 2.6 KCH shall convey KCH Telephony Calls during those periods of time and at the same standard and quality of service as KCH conveys similar Calls.

2.7 Each party shall correct faults which occur in its System which affect the conveyance of KCH Telephony Calls in accordance with such Party's normal engineering practices. For the avoidance of doubt, neither party warrants that its System is, or will be, free from faults.

**3. Routing**

3.1 The conveyance of KCH Telephony Calls shall be in accordance with the routing principles specified in Annex 2.

**4. Charging**

4.1 For the conveyance of each KCH Telephony Call by KCH, the Operator shall pay KCH a charge calculated in accordance with the rate for such a Call specified from time to time in the Kingston Interconnection Price List.

4.2 For the conveyance of each KCH Telephony Call by KCH, which is also a Transfer Charge Call, KCH shall pay the Operator a charge calculated in accordance with the rate for such a Call specified from time to time in the Kingston Interconnection Price List, and the Operator shall pay no charge to KCH pursuant to paragraph 4.1.
